



Cafes

Crisis Skylight (Old Fire Station, 40 George Street, OX1 2AQ) for Fairtrade hot drinks and support their work with the homeless.

Restore and Garden Café (Manzil Way, OX4 1YH) provides an ethically-sourced café menu and the organisation supports people with mental health problems to do the things they want to do including training and gardening opportunities.

AMT Coffee (outside St Michael's Church on Cornmarket Street, the Westgate Centre and Oxford Train Station) serving Fairtrade hot drinks made with organic milk

Ox Co-Op Shop (open every Friday afternoon during term in the Oxford Hub, above Turl Street Kitchen) is run by students for students, offering local veg boxes and a great range of Fairtrade, organic and ethically sourced store cupboard essentials
